Rules and Regulations

General Guidelines

- Absolutely no alcoholic beverages will be consumed at any Scotlandville Sports Academy sponsored function, i.e. practice, games, banquets, etc.
- Absolutely no obscene language, this includes the “N”-word, at any time (practice, meetings, games, etc.).
- All decisions made by coaches regarding Student Athletes’ participation and discipline are final
- If any Student Athlete disrespects any adult (parent, coach, etc.), he/she will be severely reprimanded by the academy.
- Absolutely no fighting, horse play, or wrestling at practice or games.
- Absolutely no negative comments are allowed at any time.
- Parents and family members must conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times.
- All fees are due on time.

Specific Guidelines

Board Of Directors

- All board members must be active volunteers within the organization.
- The board will consist of the following offices: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
- Officers cannot hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms.
- The Board of Directors shall create and monitor Volunteer Committees to assist in reaching the academy’s goals.
- The Board of Directors will organize an Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will consist of Board of Directors’ officers, each Volunteer Committees’ chairperson, and coaches. The Executive Committee shall meet at least once a month to report each functions progress.

Parents

- Parents are expected be actively involved with all activities of the academy.
- Parents are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship at every activity.
- Parents are expected to serve on at least one Volunteer Committee.
- Parents are expected to encourage all Student Athletes in education and athletics.
- Parents are expected to ensure Student Athletes are on time for practice.
- Parents are expected to attend all parents meeting.

Coaches

- Coaches should be committed to the development of all Student Athletes.
- Coaches should educate Student Athlete on sports rules and regulations.
- Coaches should expose Student Athlete to all positions in the sport.
- Coaches should motivate Student Athletes to do their best on and off the field.
- Coaches should communicate all problems to parents.
- Coaches should ensure all Student Athletes are monitored during activities.
- Coaches should monitor Student Athletes development progress.
- Coaches are expected to attend every practice and game.
- Coaches are to assign Assistant Coaches to appropriate areas.
- Coaches are automatically members of the Equipment Committee.
- Coaches are not authorized to create any communications (letters, flyers, brochures, etc.) without the written consent of the board.
- Coaches are not authorized to contact any businesses, parents, or any parties without the written consent of the board.
- Coaches are not authorized to fundraise for Scotlandville Sports Academy without the written consent of the board.

Student Athletes

- Student Athletes are expected to respect coaches at all times.
- Student Athletes are expected to work hard.
- Student Athletes are expected to do well in school. A Student Athlete must maintain a 2.5 GPA or better to remain a member of the academy. First offense will cause the Student Athlete to be placed on probation. Second offense will be grounds for dismissal from the academy.
- Student Athletes are expected to be on time for practice.
- Student Athletes are required to participate in all academy sponsor activities.
- Student Athletes are expected to have fun and learn.

Volunteer Committees

- Education – Responsible for coordinating the seminars and mentoring programs. Also responsible for tracking Student Athlete's progress in school.
- Training – Responsible for educating and exposing Student Athletes to all aspects of the sport. The Head Coach chairs this committee.
- Equipment – Responsible for assisting coaches on obtaining proper equipment and uniforms.
- Banquet- Responsible for coordinating all season ending banquets activities.
- Fundraisers – Responsible for all fundraising activities.
- Community Relations – Responsible for all community awareness projects and partnering programs.
